- 2) If you pay tax at the higher rate of 40%, then you can claim further tax relief on your Self Assessment tax return. This relief currently equates to 18% of the gross donation.

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Under Schedule 2 of the 1993 Charities Act, the University of Oxford, and its colleges, and departments, is described as an 'Exempt Charity'.
